Auxiliary Bridge Luncheon is a great success

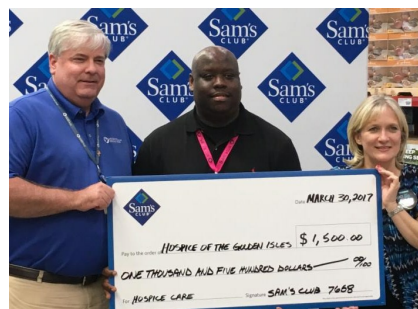
