Brunswick, GA – May 15, 2015 — Hospice of the Golden Isles has been named a 2015 Hospice Honors Elite recipient by DEYTA, an industry leader in data-driven management. Hospice Honors is a prestigious program that recognizes hospices providing the highest level of satisfaction as measured from the caregiver’s point of view.

“This is the third year that we are presenting this award to top performers, and it’s very rewarding to recognize their hard work and commitment to improving care,” said Kevin Porter, Senior Vice President of Deyta Analytics.

This notable recognition is determined by using the DEYTA Evaluation of Hospice Care survey results from approximately 1,700 partnering hospices in the U.S. For the past three years, DEYTA has identified Hospice Honors recipients by evaluating hospices’ performance on a set of eighteen satisfaction indicator measures. DEYTA established a special program, Hospice Honors Elite, to honor hospices scoring above the DEYTA National Average on one hundred percent of the evaluated questions.

HGI is one of only 38 hospices nationwide – only 2 in GA - to receive the Hospice Honors Elite award. HGI is the only hospice to receive Hospice Honors all three years and the Elite designation two consecutive years.
